

# Action themed Charades

How to play:

- Print off and cut out each of the charade cards. (If you don't have a printer you can write them down on separate bits of paper.) Shuffle them and place the pile upside down.
- Pick a player who will mime first. This player then turns over the top card to see what their 'action' is. They then have 60 seconds to mime the word on the piece of paper, whilst the rest of the players guess.
- Everyone in the team takes it in turn to mime and guess.



What does mime mean?

Miming means using gestures and movement to act out the word without saying it. For example, for football you could pretend to kick an imaginary ball or for sleeping you could close your eyes and put your head on your hands. *You cannot: make any noises, mouth the words or draw the letters in the air*
